Goods Covered: All goods and merchandise of the assured consisting principally of but not limited to furniture, fabric, and any other goods usual to the business of the assured.

Valuation: Insured value of each shipment is to be declared upon the commercial invoice, plus all freight charges plus 10%, plus duty reported separately.

Insuring Conditions: Shipments insured hereunder are insured against all risks of physical loss or damage from any external cause irrespective of percentage, but excluding, nevertheless, the risks Free of Capture and Seizure Warranty and the Strikes, Riots and Civil Commotions Warranty. From each claim the sum of \$1,000 shall be deducted. All other terms and conditions are subject to Liberty Mutual Insurance Co., Open Cargo Policy No. NYOMC10149002.

Reporting: All shipments must be reported electronically to the insurance company at the time of shipment. Report must include the name of the ship.

- This policy covers all shipments, unless prohibited by the United States of America law or United States of America governmental decree, at and from ports and/or places in the world to and at ports and/or places in the world directly or via ports and/or places in any order, including the risk of transshipment.
- The cargo policy covers all shipments; the only situation where the rating of the cargo policy may be subject to additional premiums would be on cargo war risk where certain countries are "held covered" which allows underwriters to charge a higher rate due to increase war/strikes riots and civil commotions exposures.
